





We invite you to use this kit to help generate imagery and stories for SEED, a public art project being designed for the southeast corner of E. Hastings St. at Penticton. The site will feature custom seating and vibrant plantings, integrated with anecdotes and imagery created collaboratively with local residents. The imagery and stories you share with the *SEED Story Kit* will help us design a public art site that is reflective of the Hastings Sunrise neighbourhood.

Use the activities in this kit to creatively document local bird habitat and share stories about personal experiences of migration. Do a single activity or try out all four! The material generated will be shared on our project website at mediaundefined.ca/seed. Follow the development of a collaborative online map that features habitat discovery routes, imagery, and anecdotes.

Activity 1: TAKE A WALK

TAKE A WALK in your neighbourhood with the aim of locating sites rich with bird activity.

- A. Trace your route on the map inside this card.
- B. Create symbols to identify locations where you hear bird song, see nests, or find bird habitat areas. Include a legend for the symbols you use.
- C. Add your route to the collaborative SEED map by visiting www.mediaundefined.ca/seed. There you can share your images of bird habitat, song and nest locations. Or, enclose your material in this kit and we will add it for you.



Activity 2: LISTEN

LISTEN for bird songs in your neighbourhood.

- A. Find a location rich with bird habitat. Close your eyes and listen carefully to the pattern of a bird-call.

- B. Create a drawing on the other side of this card to visually describe the bird song you hear.

Activity 3: AT HOME

AT HOME find a sample of your parents' or grandparents' handwriting in any language (eg. from a personal letter or a recipe.)

- A. Enclose a sample (or copy) of your parents' or grandparents' handwriting in this kit. Consider providing an English language translation to share its message more broadly.
- B. Use the collaborative SEED map (www.mediaundefined.ca/seed) to mark the following two locations: where that parent or grandparent lived and where you live today.
- C. Share a story about the path you or your family followed that brought you to live in this neighbourhood today. Use the other side of this card to write your story, and add more paper if you need additional space.

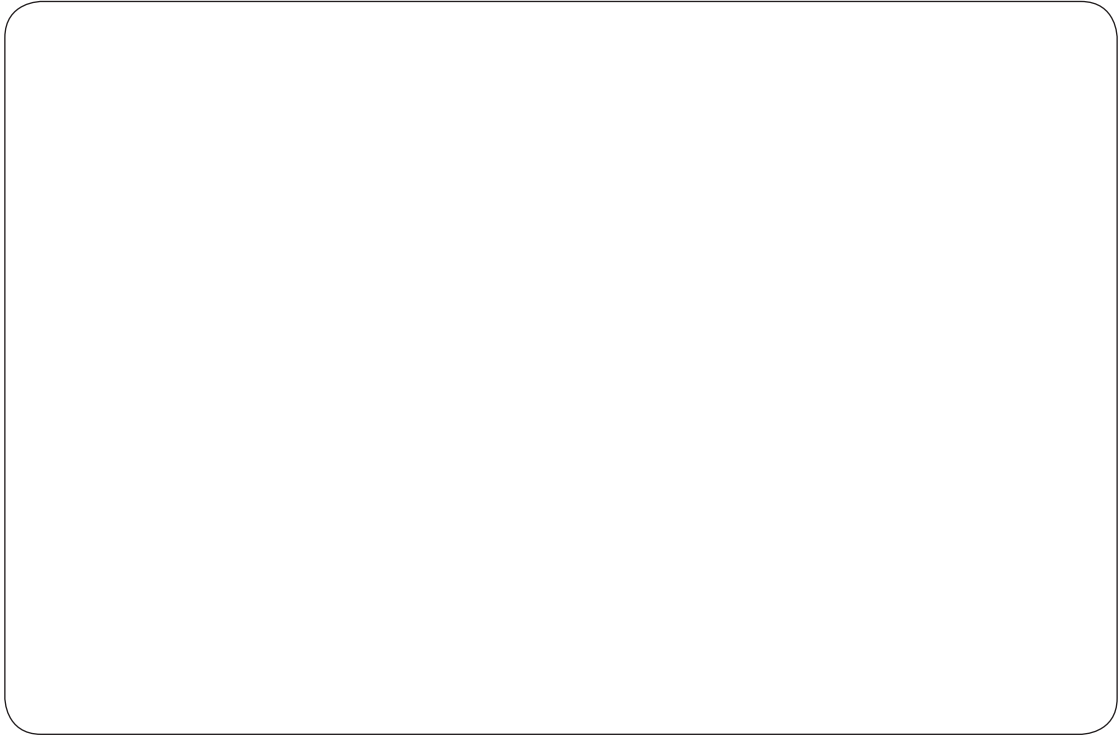
Activity 4: COLLECT

COLLECT a few seeds from a plant in the neighbourhood or from your own garden.

- A. Place the seeds in the small bag provided. On the label include your name, the date, and – if you know it – the name of the plant the seeds were harvested from.
- B. On the other side of this card draw an image of both the seed and the plant it was harvested from.
